- *New Technology for Farmers in Kenya: "New Heroes" Martin Fisher and Nick Moon*

This is an amazing story about what a difference a little technology can make. These two men saw that there were farmers in Kenya who could grow more abundant crops if they didn't have to water the seedlings by hand. But how do you solve an irrigation problem like that in an area that doesn't have access to electricity? You'll see that they came up with an ingenious solution.

- *Train Platform Schools for Children in India: "New Hero" Inderjit Khurana*

India is home to nearly half a billion children, many of whom live in extreme poverty. A teacher in a town 300 miles south of Calcutta noticed that many children from the slums spent their days begging on the train platforms, rather than going to school. She found an ingenious way to tackle this problem.

While affordable health care in America is a serious issue, it pales in comparison to the problems in India. Here we take cataract surgery for granted. We all know someone who has had it. In southern India, untreated cataracts cause blindness in millions. But that is changing through the innovative ideas and compassion of an Indian eye surgeon and an American entrepreneur.
